The teaching of the jurisprudence of worship is based on the systematic and analytical presentation of jurisprudential rulings related to prayer, fasting, zakat, and hajj, with each ruling linked to its legal evidence from the Holy Qur'an, the Sunnah of the Prophet and the sayings of jurists. 2. It focuses on developing the skill of jurisprudential reasoning among students through the analysis of legal texts, explaining the aspect of significance, and discussing the reasons for the difference between the schools of thought in controversial issues, in a way that enhances comparative understanding and deepens awareness of the principles of deduction. 3. It relies on organized classroom discussion to address traditional and contemporary jurisprudential problems, and to encourage students to participate in scientific evidence based on evidence. 4. It includes an applied aspect in some topics of worship, especially those related to the performance of prayers, the calculation of zakat, and the treatment of the calamities associated with fasting and Hajj, in a way that links theoretical knowledge with practical reality. 5. It enhances learning by assigning students to short research and studies of a specific jurisprudential issue by referring to the original approved sources, while adhering to the rules of documentation and the scientific method in presentation and analysis. 


