Introducing students to the contract as a source of obligation and its elements for organizing financial transactions. 3. Introducing students to the full legal capacity enjoyed by Iraqi individuals and its resulting legal effects. 4. Introducing students to the mechanism used to determine compensation resulting from established civil liability and the approved mechanisms for calculating its amount. 5. Introducing students to how to initiate lawsuits demanding obligations incurred by the debtor. 6. Introducing students to the mechanisms for compulsory execution in-kind against defaulting debtors. 7. Introducing students to the legal methods for debt assignment and transfer of rights. 8. Introducing students to the legal methods for the extinction of obligations and the judicial legal defenses specific to each method.
