

Student Discipline Guidelines at Higher Education Institutions in Iraq

Article 1:

Students must adhere to the laws and internal regulations of the educational institution, fully respecting faculty members, administrative staff, and all employees of the institution.

Article 2:

Students are obligated to preserve the property of the educational institution and not to damage it, including classrooms, libraries, laboratories, and other public facilities.

Article 3:

Cheating in exams or any other academic activities is strictly prohibited. Any student found guilty of cheating will be subject to appropriate disciplinary actions.

Article 4:

Attendance at lectures, classes, and other academic activities is mandatory. Absence without an acceptable excuse will subject the student to disciplinary measures.

Article 5:

Engaging in activities that harm the reputation of the educational institution, whether on or off-campus, is prohibited. This includes unethical behavior, resorting to violence, or promoting extremist ideologies.

Article 6:

Smoking and the use of drugs and alcohol are completely prohibited on campus. Any student found involved in the use or possession of such substances will face legal actions.

Article 7:

Students are required to wear appropriate and modest attire in line with the values of the educational institution. Clothing with inappropriate slogans or messages is not allowed.

Article 8:

Students must adhere to the ethics of dialogue and interaction with peers and professors. This includes respecting different opinions and refraining from insults or incitement.

Article 9:

Organizing any events, gatherings, or activities on campus without prior permission from the concerned administration is prohibited.

Article 10:

Any complaints or violations related to student behavior will be investigated by a specialized committee, which will take appropriate disciplinary actions based on the nature of the violation.
