

to think like a scientist. A scientist formulates a hypothesis, tests it,	methods	
and formulates a reasonable conclusion based on the gathered		
evidence.		
In a similar way, a nurse in daily practice summarize the information		
gathered through the patient interview, physical examination and		
laboratory tests in order to formulate a nursing diagnosis and		
develop a nursing care plan. Without the ability to evaluate		
information, the nurse endangers the health and well-being of the		
patients.		
This course explores the various nutrients, their sources,	nutrition	3
metabolism, interaction, storage, and excretion. Current research is		
presented against a background of basic nutritional concepts.		
Special emphasis is placed on understanding the role nutrition plays		
in the current health care delivery system, on evaluating fads and		

fallacies, and how nutrition can be emphasized to promote health maintenance. Topics include body systems, healthy cooking techniques, dietary restrictions and guidelines, diet and disease, recipe modifications, menu planning, and nutritional concerns of the athlete or the vegetarian		
This course teaches students about sociology and how it applies to various elements of social life, including health. The emphasis is directed to themes linked to rights/rules concerns and interpersonal.	sociology	4

This study examines the social context of health and disease, its impact on individuals, groups, and communities, and the role of the community in health care. This course helps students recognize, forecast, evaluate, and address societal health issues.		
This course teaches students about the Nurses have an obligation to safeguard, respect and actively promote people's health rights at all times and in all places. This includes ensuring that adequate care is provided within the resources available and in accordance with nursing ethics. As well, the nurse is obliged to ensure that patients receive appropriate information in understandable language prior to consenting to treatment or procedures, including participation in research. The use of coercion or manipulation to obtain consent is unethical and a violation of human rights and professional codes of conduct.		5
